### TRICKS & TREATS

## MATERIALS GRAVE ROBBER GOODY BAGS

- ▶ 1"x15"x15" plastic craft foam
- ▶ 8"x8" black fabric for each goody bag
- ▶ Pre-packaged candy
- Dark gray acrylic paint
- ► Acetone (nail polish remover)
- ▶ 2" foam brush, cotton swabs, disposable container, ruler, scissors, utility knife, white fabric pencil, white string

Optional: photocopier

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- > See pattern on Page 82.
- Use acetone in well-ventilated area.
- 1. Use utility knife to carefully cut foam gravestone. NOTE: Don't worry about making clean cuts; rough edges add character to finished project. Pour acetone in disposable container. Remove some cotton from cotton swab. NOTE: Acetone dissolves plastic craft foam, so use sparingly. Dip swab in acetone and write REST IN PEACE, THANKS FOR COMING, or TAKE ONE IF YOU DARE on foam. Optional: Use foam scraps to make smaller gravestone with RIP on it.
- **2.** Paint gravestone. Use cotton swab to apply paint in crevices of epitaph. Let dry overnight.
- 3. Use pattern to trace and cut number of goody bags desired. Optional: For larger goody bag, increase size of pattern and use larger piece of fabric. Place candy in center of fabric. Bring edges together to make bag. Tie with string.

## Great ideas:

- Use small rocks to prop up gravestone and surround with pebbles and moss. Place goody bags near gravestone.
- Arrange pumpkins, dried leaves, burlap, and black tulle around gravestones.
- ► Place near front door for visiting trick-or-treaters.



# MATERIALS VAMPIRE SUCKERS

- Black paper twist
- ► Lollipops, such as Tootsie Roll® Pops®
- Photocopier or computer, scanner, printer
- ▶ Hot glue gun, glue sticks
- ▶ Red fine-tip marker, ruler, scissors, white paper

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- See patterns on Page 86.
- 1. Unfurl paper twist. Cut 3"x8" piece. Gently fold and glue paper twist over lollipop, with front shorter than back.
- **2.** Photocopy or scan and print patterns. Cut out images. Glue vest at center of lollipop. For collar, glue top corners of folded paper twist to wrap around to cover top of vest. Apply glue to bottom back of face; attach to top of lollipop.
